If you have any auto or truck expenses, this part must be completed for each vehicle used for business. If you are electing to use the standard mileage allowance (56 cents per mile), please complete Chart A. If you are electing to deduct all actual expenses, you need to complete Chart A and Chart B. Once you elect to deduct actual expenses for a car, you cannot use the standard mileage allowance. The IRS requires the taxpayer to maintain a written mileage log to verify their total and business mileage.
